

## EAST LANCASHIRE MASONIC GOLF SOCIETY

### OBJECTIVES

- a) To promote fellowship and friendship between the brethren of East Lancashire Craft Lodges
- b) To promote and encourage Non Masons to consider joining the Craft
- c) To raise funds for charitable causes, both Masonic in particular, the East Lancashire Masonic Charity and Non Masonic.

The objectives to be achieved by the organisation of Golf Competitions and other events with golf as the theme. Some of the competitions to be open to Non-Masons.

The major competition to be the Derby Cup, played over a single round, under the Stableford format and restricted to members of East Lancashire Lodges only.

The Cup to be presented by the R.W.Provincial Grand Master, at the Annual meeting of Provincial Grand Lodge, to the Master of the Lodge to which the brother with the best Stableford score is a member.

### MEMBERSHIP

Membership to be open to any brother who:

- (a) is an East Lancashire Mason.
- (b) is A member of a recognised Golf Club
- (c) holds an Official Handicap

Membership will run from 1st January each year with the Annual subscription being a sum that can be varied from time to time by the Committee. The initial subscription shall be £7.00 and all subscription shall be by Standing Order.

Membership shall entitle each member to receive advance notice of any competition or event.

For certain events membership will be necessary, Priority, if Open events are oversubscribed, will be given to members.

### ORGANISATION

The Organisation shall be vested in the Committee consisting of the following:-

Chairman  
Vice Chairman  
Secretary  
Treasurer

It is envisaged that each golf competition / event, will have a named organiser who serves on the Committee for that purpose and event only.

An Annual General Meeting will be held at which a report on the year's activities will be given. The Treasurer will also produce annual audited accounts. This meeting will be held in conjunction with one of the golf events.

The Committee members will be selected by the Provincial Grand Master. The Provincial Grand Master will be President of the Society by virtue of his office and will act as adjudicator in the event of any disputes. All residual funds in the event of the Society being wound up will belong to the ELMC.
