## **50/60/70/80 Year Certificates**

Further to the recent meeting of the Craft Executive, I can now confirm that all members of the Province, both subscribing and Honorary Members will now be eligible for a Long Service Certificate.

The following procedure will apply:

1. The Province will circulate once a year, a list of the Brethren / Companions who will be eligible for the award of a Long Service Certificate.  
  
Please note that you should advise me of any East Lancashire Brother / Companion, who will be eligible (e.g. an Honorary Member) but not on the list.
2. The responsibility for the research of the Brother's / Companion's eligibility is yours.
3. The information should then be placed on the 'Application Form' section of the Secretariat Website - <http://www.pg1el.co.uk/Secretariat/50th/appendix1.asp>
4. The Secretariat will then verify the information and prepare the Provincial Certificate and the letter from the RW Provincial Grand Master / ME Grand Superintendent.

Please note that the application should be received, via the Secretariat Web site, at least three months before the required date for the Certificate and letter to be collected from the Provincial Office.

If your enquiries have to extend to another Province / Constitution, the appropriate 'document of introduction,' is available from the Secretariat.
